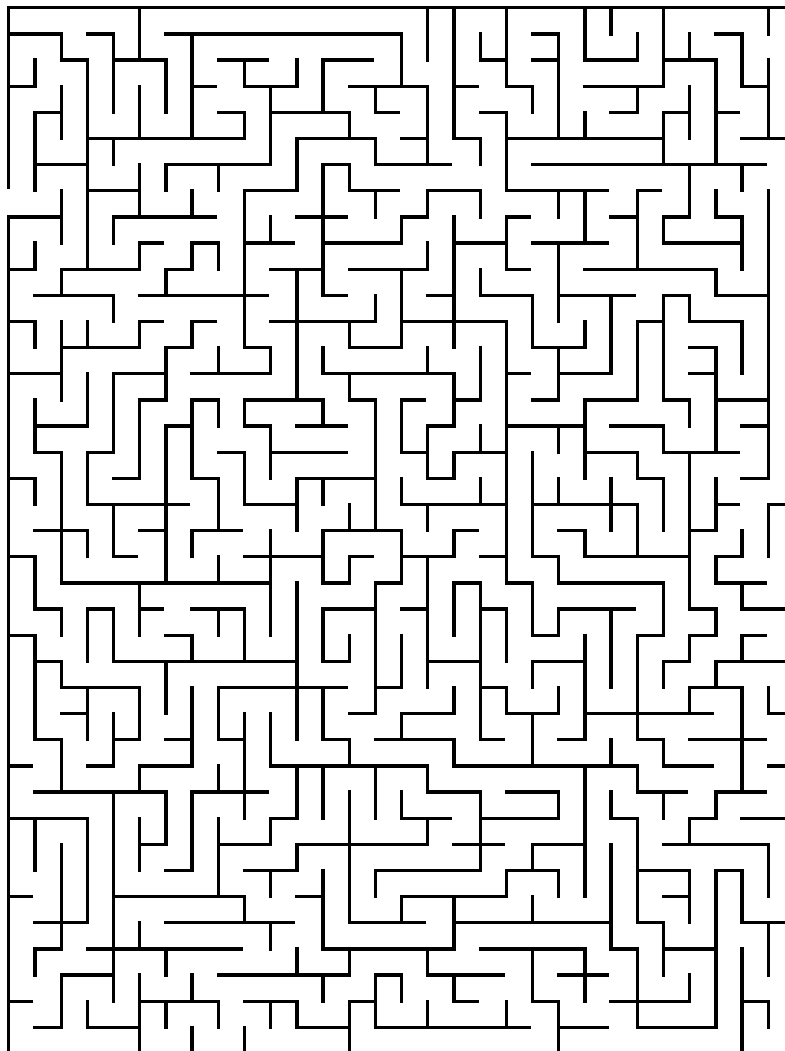

Jim Crow was not a real person. He was a late 1800s cartoon-like figure portraying African-American persons in a belittling way. The term Jim Crow applied to the period of time from the late 1800s until the 1960s when laws kept blacks separated from whites and treated them unequally in almost every way.
